

Daily Self Certification

IDPH requires that schools conduct symptom screenings and temperature checks or require that individuals self-certify that they are free of symptoms before entering the school building.

These are the daily questions that each student or parent will have to be able to answer “NO” to gain entrance into the building.

- 1) Have you received a confirmed diagnosis for COVID-19 by a COVID test or from a diagnosis by a healthcare professional in the past 14 days?
- 2) Have you had close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
- 3) Have you experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms in the last 14 days (to include: fever or temperature greater than 100.4 degrees, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, pressure in chest, extreme fatigue, earache, persistent headache, diarrhea, persistent loss of smell or taste.)

If “NO” is selected: Based on your answers, you are **ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING**

If “YES” is selected: Based on your answers, you are **NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.**
